The ocean is a key component of the Earth system (Chapter 1) as it provides essential life supporting services (Inniss et al., 2017 1). For example, it stores heat trapped in the atmosphere caused by increasing concentrations of greenhouse gases, it masks and slows surface warming, it stores excess carbon dioxide and is an important component of global biogeochemical cycles.
