Capitation payments control use of health care resources by putting the physician at financial risk for services provided to patients.

Some argue that capitation is a more cost-efficient and responsible health care model, and there is evidence to support this claim. A 2009 review of studies reported that capitation was most cost-effective in groups with moderate health care needs, with practices reporting fewer illnesses and more enrollments than fee-for-service practices.

In the capitation system, physicians are paid per patient instead of per service. Capitated HMOs require members to see professionals within their system of clinics and hospitals, with no access to out-of-network coverage. Costs are sometimes lower, but so are options for providers and patients.

### How Your Doctor is Paid: Wage, Capitation, and Fee-For ...

Capitation is typically a per member per month (PMPM) payment to a medical group/IPA or facility that covers contracted services for assigned members. This is an alternative to the fee-for-service arrangement. Capitation payments made whether or not the member seeks services from the capitated care provider.

Capitation for outpatient primary care is a good example, a common one. That would generally cover a standard set of primary care services under the capitation agreement. This would leave other things outside the scope of the capitation agreement.

### Capitation Payment Systems: Scope of Capitation ...

Translated into a compensation model, capitation involves distribution of health plan payments among physicians in a nearly equal manner or based on some type of formula. Pros and cons. On the plus side, capitation rewards groups, and in turn those groups' individual physicians, who deliver cost-efficient, effective care.

Under capitation, hospitals and physicians receive a fixed, per capita monthly payment in exchange for agreeing to provide a specified set of services. It is critical to understand what services are included in the capitation payment, what (if anything) can be billed separately, and what is not covered as a benefit.
