Crossing the Colorado River. Down river from Glen Canyon Dam, the historical town of Lee's Ferry lies in the break between Glen, Marble and Paria canyons. A natural corridor between Utah and Arizona, Lee's Ferry was named for, and settled by Mormon John D. Lee, who established the first Colorado River crossing at this site.
