The granting of greater local control over forests through tenure reform has created more opportunities for community forestry and possibilities to improve local livelihoods. However, these reforms entail complex shifts in multiple rights and responsibility as well as changes in the relationships between formal rights recipients, government agencies and other stakeholders.

Strong community forest rights help communities protect their forests, reducing CO₂ emissions from deforestation and improving forest health. Community Forest Rights When the Forest Rights Act was passed in December 2006, the tribal villagers of Madavan Gouri in the Sagar district of Madhya Pradesh were completely unaware of the fact that they could now apply for their rights to the forest land that they used, both individually and as a community.

Community Forest Rights

For example, community royalties from deals with logging companies in Afanloum Forest were managed by a self-appointed group of just four people who had consistently abused the system, handing out multiple logging contracts without working out the amount of timber that could be cut sustainably.
